



Scholarship General Information

Two \$1000 scholarships will be awarded to a Latino (a) student enrolled or planning to enroll in the fall in a regionally accredited Illinois college or university. Selection will be based on academic record, personal statement, recommendations, and demonstrated commitment to community/campus /high school service.

Eligibility

- New or continuing Latino undergraduate students who have a current cumulative GPA of at least a 3.00 (on a 4.00 scale) or a 4.00 (on a 5.0 scale) from a regionally accredited Illinois college/university or high school (whichever is applicable).
- Applicant **MUST** plan to be enrolled as a full-time undergraduate student during the next fall term.
- This scholarship is available once. No renewals will be awarded.

Application Procedure

An official application PACKET must be completed and submitted by the student no later than **June 1** (prior to fall term attendance). A completed application packet consists of:

- A typed or neatly printed ILACHE Scholarship Application Form.
- A personal statement (must include the applicant's career objectives, plans for graduate or professional study (if applicable), and community/campus/high school service involvement.
- Two letters of recommendation (one of the letters **MUST** be from a teacher/faculty member who has taught you in the classroom and/or laboratory setting and can assess your academic ability.)
- An official high school and/or college transcript, whichever is applicable. High school transcript must indicate date of graduation.
